Year 7	Bugs Life Textiles based project exploring the shapes and patterns found on a variety of insects. 3D textiles outcome.	Weaving Street A collaborative project based on the Spanish village of Valverde de la Vera. Recycling plastic bags into woven pattern creating a bright and colourful canopy installation.	Dead Heads Clay based project exploring imagery surrounding the Mexican Day of The Dead Festival and developing ceramics skills.	1950's Pattern Prints Print based project exploring the pattern and colour of 1950's Britain and the work of Lucienne Day.	Illustration Developing imaginative and creative responses to descriptions of characters from a range of classic childrens literature.	Painting Portfolio Exploring a variety of painting techniques developing skills in colour mixing and creating depth and tone.
	Year 8 Henri Matisse Style Figures Investigating figure drawing and experimenting with compositional techniques and mixed media skills.	Cultural Masks Ceramics based project, exploring the imagery of different cultures and developing 3D craft skills.
