

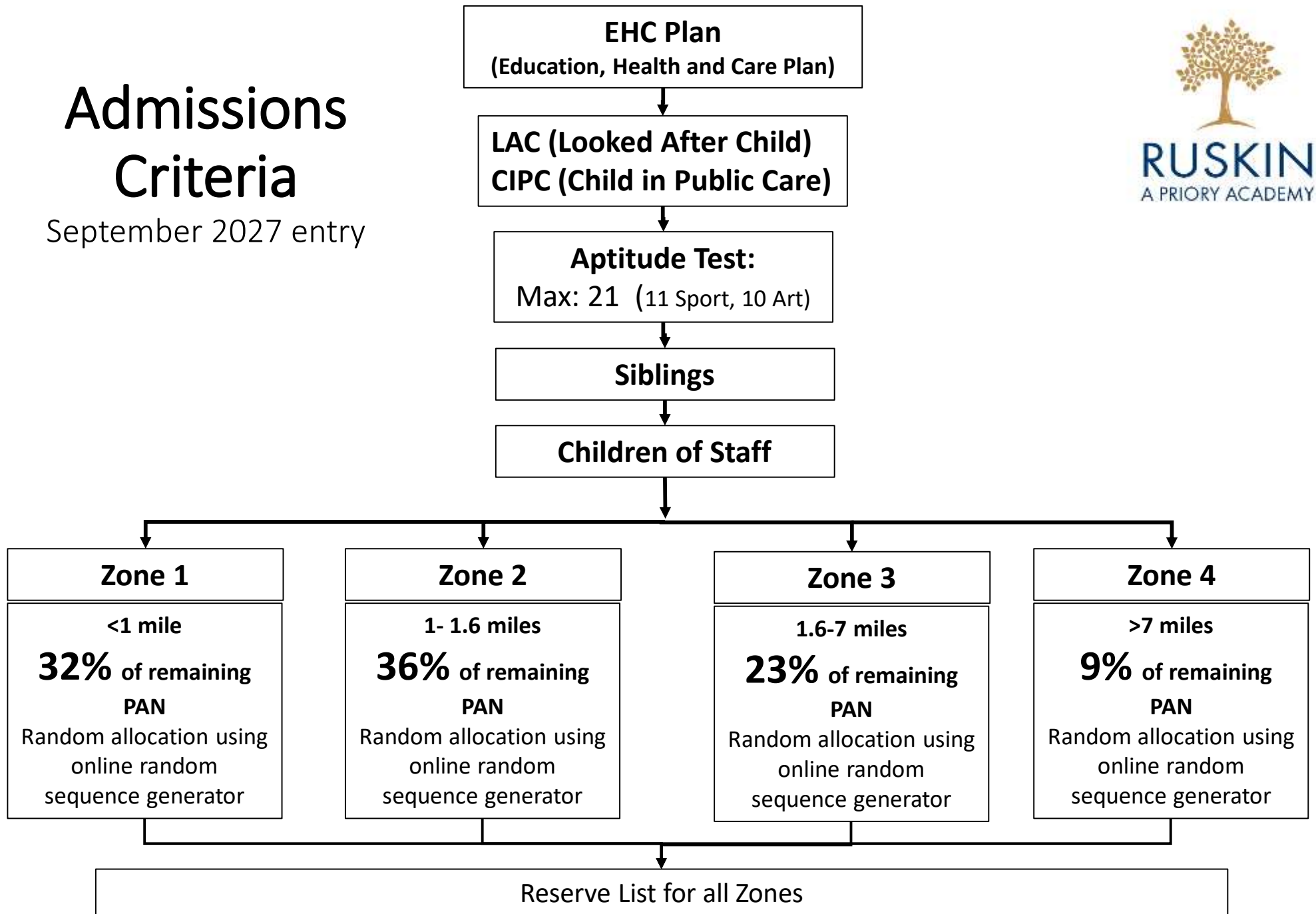


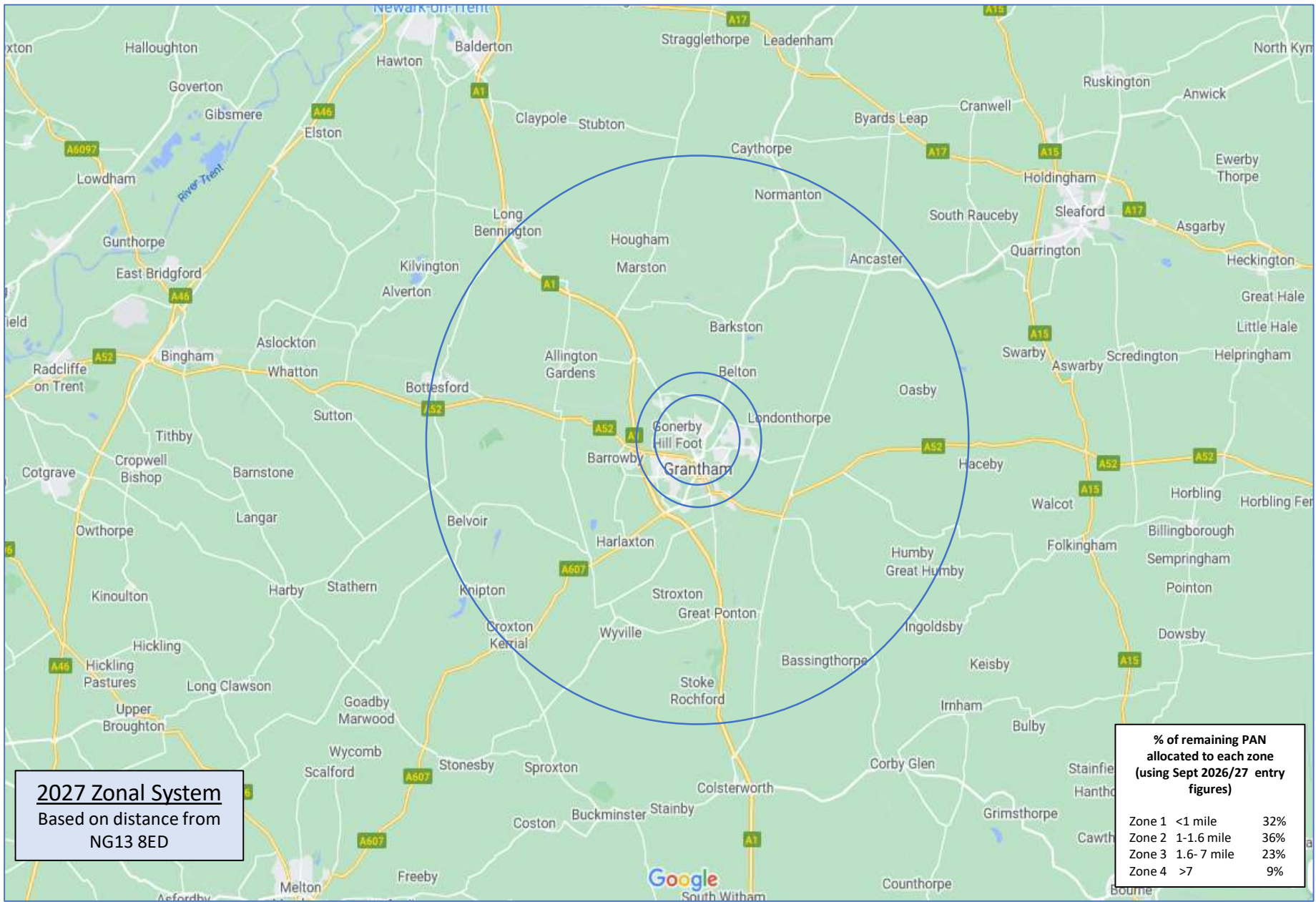

Admissions Criteria

September 2027 entry





Aptitude Tests



The Priory Ruskin Academy will admit up to 10% of the PAN (21 students) in Year 7 on the basis of their aptitude for Sport or the Visual Arts, Priory Ruskin's Specialist subjects.

- Places are given to students who are particularly gifted in either of the specialism subjects and reach a required standard
- Applicants can apply to take either or both of the aptitude tests.
- Application forms for the aptitude assessment are online through the schools website, and should be completed by **Friday 3rd July (Art) and Monday 6th July (Sport)**.
- Students do not need to take an aptitude assessment, and this will not effect their standard application to Priory Ruskin Academy or the allocated places.
- Application for an aptitude assessment does not constitute an application of the Priory Ruskin Academy and you must also complete the **Lincolnshire Common Application Form**.

Sport & Health

- Applicants will be assessed on their sporting abilities, using six activities to test their agility, stamina, speed and strength.
- Applicants will not be allocated a place due to the team they play for or the sporting events that they have completed.



Assessment tests will take place in the Academy Sports Centre, 3.50pm – 5.45pm on:

Wednesday 8th July

Monday 13th July

Tuesday 14th July

The deadline to book onto the tests is MONDAY 6TH JULY

Visual Arts

- Visual Arts portfolios can include photographs, drawings, paintings, models or mixed media images. **The deadline to submit portfolios is FRIDAY 3RD JULY**

Each portfolio should be clearly labelled with the students name, address, etc and portfolios can be collected from the Academy on Tuesday 14 and Wednesday 15th July.

Making an Application for Year 7



You will need to **complete a Lincolnshire Common Application Form.**

You will be asked to give 3 choices for your chosen school.

You should give 3 choices. If you only put one choice and you do not get that choice the LCC will allocate you a place at a school/academy that is under PAN.

Putting PRA as a first choice is not a guarantee that you will be offered a place.

You must **include the names of any siblings** who are within the academy, or you may miss the opportunity of a place.
