



What is a timetable?

You will be given your own personal timetable on Day 1. You will have 5 lessons each day. Your timetable will inform you about the following:

- Lessons you will have each day
- The room in which each lesson will take place in.
- The name of the teacher you will have for each subject. (This is shown by the teacher initials next to lesson)
- The equipment you will need to pack in your bag the night before.

Do you have a watch? Do you need one? It might be a good idea to practise telling the time and getting to places on time.
